FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Plan to plug back from 4,993' to 4,848' with 12 sacks cement. Casing is set at 4,943', which will cement 95' up in casing. Hole will then be filled with heavy mud-laden fluid to 2,926'. Will then plug back with 10 sacks cement (base of salt). Will fill with heavy mud to 2,510' (top of salt). Will plug back with 10 sacks cement. Will fill with heavy mud to 202' (base of surface string) and plug with 10 sacks cement. Will fill with heavy mud and plug with 10 sacks cement at top of surface pipe and set a pipe marker 4 feet above ground.

Our Houston Office has checked with the local office of the OPC to see if there would be any requirements as to permit or notice of intention to abandon from Federal Regulatory ~~authorities~~ agencies, and they state that it would be OK to proceed without any reference to them as long as we complied with applicable State regulations.
