FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK (FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Rapid increase in water percentage since completion of well has killed the well and has made the installation of pumping equipment unjustifiable from an economic standpoint; therefore, we desire to squeese perforations from 12057' to 12073' with 100 sacks of cement, and perforate casing from 12033' to 12049' with 4 shots per foot. Complete workover operations by acidising with 1000 gallons of 15% regular acid through perforations.
