Manzano Oil Corporation proposes to convert the plugged and abandoned Union Oil Company of California State "22" #1 well to a water disposal well. The State "22" #1 is located on 2310 FSL & 990 FEL of Section 22, Township 10 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is estimated that 800 barrels of water per day maximum shall be injected at 900 psi into the San Andres zone at a depth of 5010' to 5260'.
