

AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER SWD-454

APPLICATION OF TOCO L.L.C., TRAINER OIL COMPANY FOR SALT WATER DISPOSAL, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 701(B), Toco L.L.C., Trainer Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on January 9, 1996, for permission to complete for salt water disposal its Morse 'A' Well No.1 located 660 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 28, Township 10 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

## THE DIVISION DIRECTOR FINDS THAT:

- (1) The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations;
- (2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and surface owners have been duly notified;
- (3) The applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met; and
  - (4) No objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The applicant herein, is hereby authorized to complete its Morse 'A' Well No.1 located 660 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 28, Township 10 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the San Andres formation at approximately 5196 feet to 5390 feet through 2 7/8-inch plastic-lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 5096 feet.
