DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total Depth of subject well 11805'. Displaced water in hole w/crude oil. WESTERN pumped 500 gallons mud acid into tubing in 4 minutes (oil returns from casing going into stock tank), then pumped 54.5 bbls. oil into tubing, displacing acid to bottom of tubing string. Set packer and nipped up Xmas tree. WESTERN pumped 15-1/2 bbls. of oil into tubing in 8 minutes. Broke formation w/1950# and pressure gradually decreased to 1150# at end of acid squeeze. Squeezing through 2-1/2" EUE tubing and OTIS Side-Door Choke (7/8" I.D.). Swabbed for 16-1/2 hrs. and recovered 270 bbls. fluid and small amount of gas. Fluid 10% oil and 90% slightly salty water.
