Spot 30 sx cement plug 11895-11875', spot 100 sx cement plug 9800-9635', spot 30 sx cement plug from 5050-4925'. (8-5/8" Intermediate Casing seat @ 5000'). Spot 10 sx cement plug in top of 13-3/8" surface casing. Placed mud laden fluid between all plugs and erected regulation 4' monument. Well plugged and abandoned June 6, 1956.

Location is now ready for inspection. Inspected 11/16/56 OK. *WAS*

Monument actually about 6' tall (above ground)
