

This filing is made for authorization to transport oil produced during periods of testing. The well was recently tested for El Paso Natural Gas Company and sufficient tank storage was available but subsequent testing may require movement of oil from the tanks for additional storage.

Remarks

The #1 J. M. Brown was first completed as an oil well in May, 1959 and an oil allowable was authorized May 6, 1959. On November 1, 1959 the well was shut in under field rules designating the Sawyer San Andres Gas Pool. Negotiations with El Paso Natural Gas Co. have been continuous since that date to commence operations under a gas purchase contract with El Paso Natural Gas Company and the latest tests were at the request of El Paso to determine the deliverability of the well.
