DETAILS OF WORK

This well is running approximately the same as the nearest well one mile south west. We are requesting a change in plan of drilling in.

Instead of running 7"OD casing we will drill the well in by coring, where the formation is not too hard to permit coring with a Hughes Type J hard formation core barrel, have the cores analyzed, submitting a complete report to the U. S. G. S. office at Roswell. If the reports indicate that we have a well, casing will be run and cemented with enough cement to bring it to the base of the salt.

Casing will be set in or near the top of the pay section.

This change was confirmed by Mr. Canfield, April 30, 1948.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
