This well was originally drilled by Devonian Oil Company and completed as an oil well January 4, 1947 (see Devonian's form 9-330 and C-105 dated January 14, 1947 and February 14, 1947 respectively). In October 1949 (21-29) Devonian perforated 7" casing at 2322 and squeezed cement (Top of Rustler). See form 9-331a filed 11/16/49 approved 11/23/49. It was produced as an oil well by Devonian, then Warren and Gulf Oil Corporation until November 1, 1959 when it was shut in as a gas well pursuant to Conservation Commission Order No. R-1517. Title was acquired by Cooley and Holcomb and subsequently on April 1, 1965 operation passed to Ralph S. Cooley.

The well was recompleted as a gas well by Cooley and Holcomb 2/15/65 (see C-104 filed 2/16/65 approved 3/4/65 and C-116 filed 2/16/65). During the long shut in period the well loaded up with water and heavy emulsion and all attempts to unload the well and obtain commercial production have failed. Swabbing the well does not result in sufficient production to pay for itself and within a few days gas volume has decreased below gathering line pressure. The quarter section on which this well is located is surrounded by commercial production. Operator wishes to plug and abandon this well and drill a new well, Brown "51" No. 1-A, in the diagonal southeast corner (continued on attached)
