

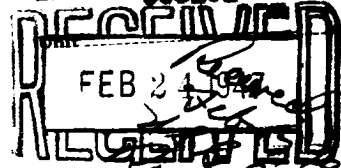

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Our notice of intention to drill dated November 25, 1946, proposed to cement the 7" casing at about 4325 feet with 75 sacks of cement and then perforate and squeeze the necessary amount of cement behind the pipe to protect the salt section, amount and depths of such squeeze job to be worked out with your office.

The 7" casing was cemented at 4325 feet with 300 sacks of cement and tested O.K. Top of salt section was encountered at 2370 feet and base of salt section at 2300 ft.

We now propose to delay the cement squeeze job at the top of the salt until some time within 60 days after placing the well on the pump. Depth of cementing and amount of cement to be used will be discussed with your office before commencing the work. Confirming conversation with Messrs. Wolfe, Soyster and Barnett at Roswell Jan 27, 1947.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
