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Personal Bond and Letter of Credit Accepted

On September 24, 1990, this office received a personal bond and a Letter of Credit in the amount of \$25,000 for all Federal oil and gas leases held by the obligor(s) in the State of New Mexico. The bond and the Letter of Credit have been examined and found acceptable. The bond is therefore accepted effective September 24, 1990, the date we received all required forms.

The bond constitutes coverage for all interests and development obligations of, or on behalf of, the obligor(s) in Federal oil and gas leases in the State of New Mexico. Coverage under the bond does not extend to additional obligors, such as assignees of all or part of the obligor's interest in any lease.

The pledge for the bond is a Letter of Credit written by the above indicated financial institution. The document will be retained by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) until this office determines that there is no further requirement for the bond coverage or that a satisfactory replacement bond has been provided.

The letter of credit will be returned to the financial institution when this office determines that there is no further requirement for the document. The letter of credit will continue indefinitely in the absence of notice from the financial institution of a determination not to renew it; such a notice must be received by this office at least 90 days prior to the original expiration date of September 20, 1991, or the automatically extended dates falling on the same day in subsequent years. A copy of the notice should also be provided to the obligor(s) who would then be responsible for providing a replacement security. Unless the obligor provides a satisfactory replacement at least 30 days prior to the then fixed expiration date, BLM will demand that the financial institution pay the full amount of the credit to ensure continuing coverage of the obligor.

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Any such funds thus obtained will be retained, so long as none are required to correct defaults, until the bond is no longer required or the obligor furnishes a replacement bond.
