
Dear Mrs. Moore:

The Texas Company is currently disposing of all produced water in the Moore (Devonian) Pool into the Dewey Lake formation in the State of New Mexico "BN" (NCT-1) Well No. SMD-1. However, due to the importance of continuous 100% water disposal in the Moore (Devonian) Pool, it is believed that an alternate disposal facility be provided in the event our current disposal well becomes overburdened.

In accordance with existing rules of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, we are enclosing herewith a copy of The Texas Company's application to dispose of salt water produced in the Moore (Devonian) Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, down the 8-5/8" - 5-1/2" casing annulus in the subject well. The formations exposed in the proposed disposal interval are not productive of oil or gas within a radius of two miles of the proposed disposal well. In lieu of waivers, we are requesting Conservation Commission administrative approval following expiration of the fifteen-day waiting period.
