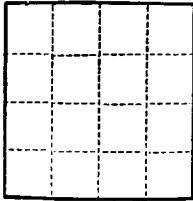

DETAILS OF WORK

Well drilled to a total depth of 9818 feet and was dry, well plugged 4/15/63 as follows: 23 sacks cement 9818 - 9718; 24 sacks 5000 - 4900; 24 sacks 4175 - 4075; pulled 1045 feet of 7 5/8 inch casing. 25 sacks of cement from 975 - 9075; 23 sacks 175 - 475; 15 sacks 0 - 75.

Steel marker is erected and pits will be leveled as soon as it is dry enough. We will notify you when pits are level.

Also, 24 sacks cement plugged from 9125 - 9025.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
