Dear Mr. Ramey:

Attached is the Form 3-103, which contains the plugging record of the Felmont-State No. 1 well, Section 28, Township 11 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

You will recall that the plugging program was discussed with you by telephone April 3, 1963 at which time your verbal approval was given to plug and abandon the well.

Drilling mud, weighing 10.4 PPG, was used to spot the cement plugs in place. No casing was pulled. Casing left in hole:

13-3/8" casing from surface to 350'

9-5/8" casing from surface to 4150'

Steel plate was welded on top of the 9-5/8" collar and a permanent marker welded to steel plate showing the following:

Felmont Oil Corporation State No. 1


