The above well was temporarily abandon in order to give the land owners and the well owner time to clear the title and to reevaluate the property, this has been accomplished. On Dec. 27, 1972 the well owner & operator aquired an O & G lease on the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 30, T9S, R35E, 10NPM from the land owners. On April 18, 1973, the well, equipment and a partial assignment of the lease was sold to Energy Producing Properties, P. O. Box 3251, Midland, Texas 79701. However; the present operator, Walter W. Anderson will operate the well until the new owners can qualify to operate in the state of New Mexico.

On June 8, 1973 the well was placed on production by installing an 4x2 $\frac{7}{8}$ ths.x2 Kobe pump on 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " tbg. in 7" 26lb. csg. at a depth 9687ft. packer set at the depth 9701ft. produced through old perf. 9737ft. to 9755ft. from the Bough C.

The average daily production is 70 brl. oil and 410 brl. of water, very small amount of gas.
