Ran 121 jts. 5-1/2" OD casing as liner set at 9435' with top of liner at 3707'.

Cemented liner with 750 sacks Trinity Inferno Class "E" cement. Pumped plug to

9348' at 9:45 AM 6-29-65 with 2000# Max. PP. Rotated casing until plug was down.

Waited 22-3/4 hrs. Ran temperature survey. Found top of cement outside 5-1/2"

casing at 6475' or 58.7% fill. Squeezed top of 5-1/2" liner at 3707' with 100

sacks reg. cement. Max. PP 2000#. Displaced cement to 3640'. Drilled out cement

to top of liner and tested with 2000# for 1/2 hr. Held OK. Drilled out cement

inside 5-1/2" casing to 9420' and tested casing with 2000# for 1/2 hr. Held OK.

Displaced hole with oil and continued with completion.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
