Gentlemen:

A physical inspection of the location for your plugged and abandoned State "D" No. 1 located in Unit J of Section 36, T-10-S, R-32-E indicated that the location was cleared and a marker erected in compliance with Commission Rules and Regulations. Before we can approve the final plugging and abandoning of the well, however, it will be necessary for you to submit Form C-105, Well Record, and two copies of a notarized tabulated list of the deviation surveys.

Our records indicate that you have been notified twice previously that it would be necessary for you to submit these forms, but to date we have had no reply. We wish to call to your attention that until the forms are submitted and the final plugging approved your plugging bond will have to remain in force.
