Dear Mr. Grace:

On January 20, 1971 this office wrote to you requesting information on your State "AI" Well No. 1 located in Unit P of Section 20, T-10-S, R-33-E. If you remember, the last report we had on this well was dated May 13, 1969 and covered re-entry, perforations, swabbing, and stated that you proposed to squeeze the bottom two perforations. Also, in my letter of January 20 I requested Form C-103 showing the present status of the well, any work done since the last report, and future plans for the well. I also stated in the letter that I expected to hear from you on this matter prior to February 1, 1971.

Since you have chosen to ignore my inquiries, and since a recent inspection of the well shows it to be non-operating, it appears in order to plug and abandon this well. If you do not answer this inquiry by April 30, I will have no choice but to request that your bonding company plug and abandon the well.
