The last report this office received on your State "AI" Well No. 1 located in Unit P of Section 20, T-10-S, R-33-E covered the re-entry of the well, perforations and swabbing. It further stated that you proposed to squeeze the bottom two perforations, swab and test. This form was dated May 13, 1969.

Please immediately file Form C-103 showing the present status of the well, any work done on the well since the last report and any future plans for the well. If you do not intend any further work on the well, then plans should be made to plug and abandon the well immediately.
