This well was taken into the Dickey Queen Sand Unit effective 10-1-59. It was formerly designated as the Philmax #2. It is proposed to sand-oil fracture, below the casing set at 2834' with 7500 gallons of oil and 15000 pounds of sand. It is believed this work will increase oil production 100 bbls per day.
