Total depth 3030', anhydrite. Ran 3026' of 5 1/2" CD 14# H-40 csg., set at 3028' and cemented with 600 sacks. Plug down July 6, 1947 at 3:00 P.M. Cement was allowed to set 30 hours, plug drilled out, 1000# pressure applied with no drop in pressure. Drilling resumed.
