## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 1:00 A.M. on August 17, 1951 32 hours had elapsed since running 9-5/8" casing set at 4674' and cemented in two stages. 1st stage was cemented w/375 sacks of 8% gel cement and 100 sacks neat. Circulated 6 hours through staging tool and cemented second stage with 50 sacks of neat cement. Temperature survey indicated top of cement at 1760'. Casing was tested with 1000# Pressure for 30 minutes before and after drilling staging tool and casing shoe. Drilled 45' hard cement above shoe.
