Tank battery consists two (2) high Five's. Sival's Tanks. size 15'6" x 16' - $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{3}{16}$ - $\frac{3}{16}$, Cone bottom type A.

Flow lines connected, B. S. & W. Pit open north of the tanks. Entire battery fenced.

Tank No. 1, half full of fluid.

Tank No. 2, within one (1) foot of being full of fluid.
