This well was spudded August 21, 1959. An 11" hole was drilled to 330'. 8-5/8", 24#, J-55 Casing was set at 328' using 250 sacks of cement (2% gel). Cement was allowed to set 30 hours before resuming operations. The casing cement was tested to 600 psi and found to be ok.
