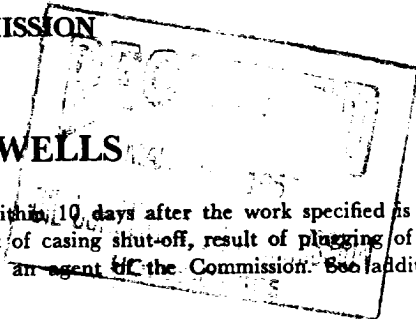

Plug back to 11,548'. 11,540' of 5 1/2" @ 11,546' with 700 sacks cement 3% Gel. Top of cement by temperature survey 8690'. Tested 5 1/2" casing with 1200 PSI for 30 min. No pressure drop. Perforated 11,430' to 11,488' with 4 shots per foot.
