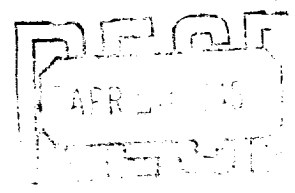

This well was completed as a pumper in December of 1939. The production has declined to an average of 20 Ebl. per day. We intend to survey the hole with Dowell Electric pilot from bottom of 5 1/2" casing at 4518' to total depth of 5068' and then treat the pay with 5000 Gallons of acid to increase the production. We expect to do this work April 24, 1945.
