DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4640 Lime. With packer set at 4500' loaded annular space above packer with 80 bbls. oil & acidized well with 1500 gal. Dowell "XXWF-6". Flushed tubing with 18 bbls. oil. Swabbed off bottom 3-1/2 hours, swabbed oil flush & acid sludge into pits, no gauge. Next 5 hours swabbed 25 bbls. fresh oil, no water. Well was then shut in to prepare for another acid treatment with 2500 gal. Dowell "XXWF-6".
