Run and cemented 366 joints and 1 piece (11,836-61) 5 7/8" O.D., 20 & 17 1/2" P-80 and 17 1/2" 7-35 seamless, 100# casing at 11,846.00' with 240 cu. ~ 4 1/2 gal. liner cement with 240 cubic feet Strata-crete followed by 100 cu. feet float cement. Top of cement at 9320' as determined by temperature survey.

Waited on cement 30 hours. Tested casing with 2350#, 0.5.
