This is in reply to your letter of June 24th, regarding
the test of the well known as well No. 1, in sec.
23, T. 10 N., R. 30 W.

Mr. J. H. Williams took this well over from National
Security and they deepened the well to 250' and plugged
back to 125'. They filled it with 5000 gallons and after
the acid they got some oil and gas, an increase in gas but
no oil. The well, however, is an old, considerable gas up the
hole and it will be considered eventually as a gas well.

I understand Mr. Williams will be here shortly, at which time
I will contact him and see what he has to participate doing.

It is rumored in the field that Virgil Linsay (the fee owner)
is not claiming the well. I shall get in touch with Mr. Linsay
as soon as possible to find out whether or not this is true.

Either I will contact Mr. Linsay, whoever it is to be
responsible for the well, to file a proper bond.
