Pressure survey: SHF at datum, 916 psi. Results of pressure survey are reported on form C-124.

Bradenhead checks: Tubing and casing pressures were as follows: Tubing 500 psi, 7" casing 0 psi (packer) 9 5/8" casing 550 psi, 13" casing 0 psi. Gas is being used from 9 5/8" casing as auxiliary fuel supply for the Hobbs Camp, and is used occasionally to kick off bowers Pay wells.

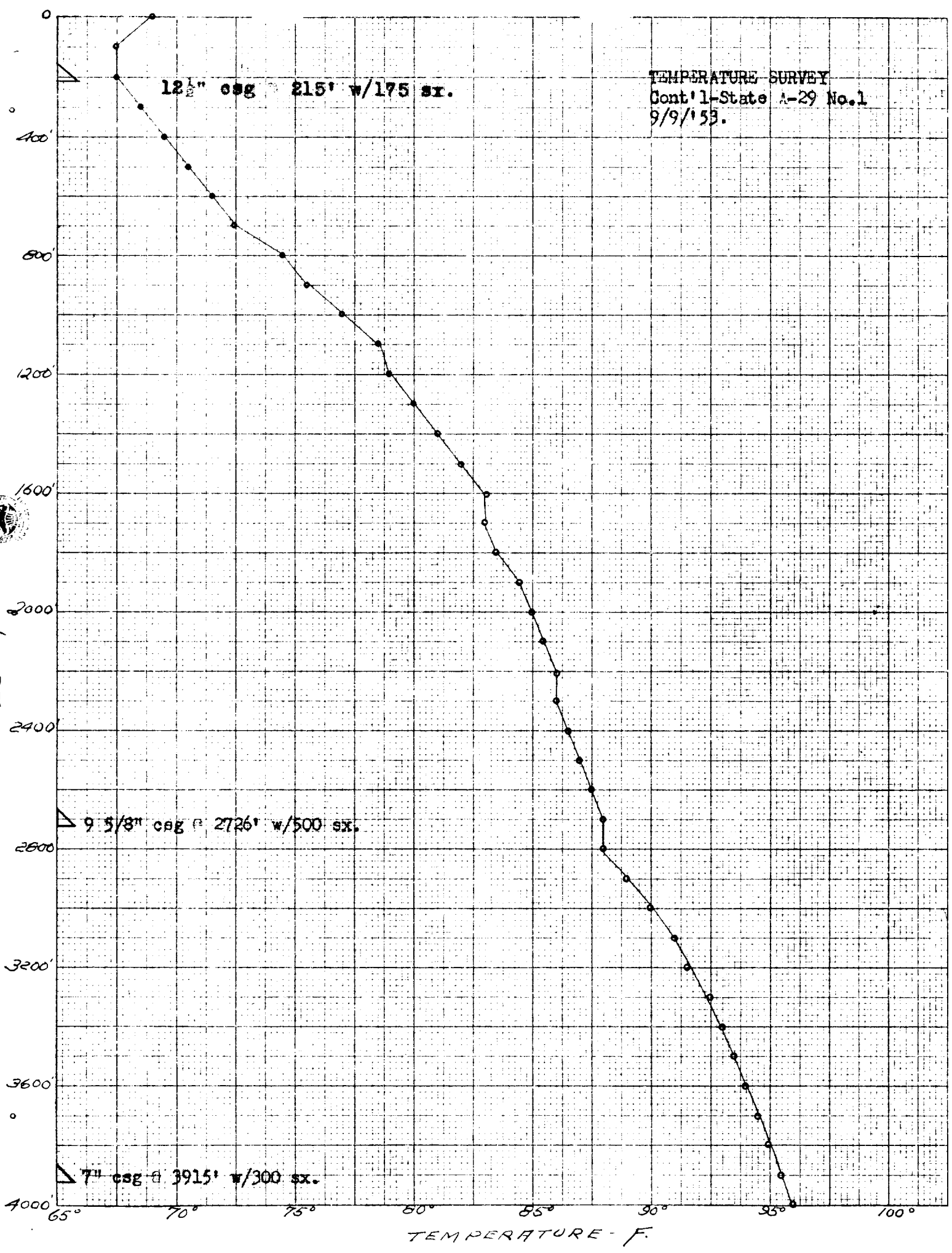
