Seely Oil Company's McElvain Federal #10 was completed during January 2002 from the Penrose perforations from 4778' - 4785'.

Since this #10 well is on the same base lease (Federal NM-0245247) as Seely Oil Company's McElvain Federal #7 and also has the same ownership, production from the #10 well is being comingled with production from the Seely Oil Company McElvain Federal #7 well at production facilities located on the NW/4 of the NW/4 of Section 29 - T18S - R34E NMPM.

Production from each well will be prorated on the basis of well tests by Seely Oil Company.

Oil is being sold to Sunoco via truck, casing head gas is being sold to Conoco through the same meter as the aforementioned #7 well (same base lease) and produced water is being disposed through Seely's EK Queen Unit water injection facilities located on the
