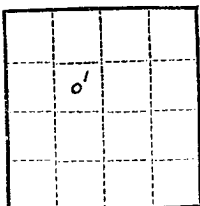

DETAILS OF WORK

The hole being full of mud, we set 75 sacks of cement at 3500 feet, placed a cement plug from 2900 feet to 1300 feet, using 310 sacks of cement; cut and pulled the 3 5/8" casing at 972 feet, and spotted 25 sacks of cement at 972 feet; set cement plug at 65 feet and filled the hole to the top, placing a 4-inch pipe marker at the top of the cement. We then cleaned the location and left the ground in its original condition.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
