FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Total depth of well is 4705'. Main oil pay 4625-4637'; additional oil pay 4693-4705'. Well is swabbing at the rate of 40 bbls. of oil per day.

Propose to run tubing to total depth, with Sweet formation packer at about 4665' and perforations at 4699-4702', also acidizing tool just above the packer. In this manner, we propose to acidize each pay zone separately. 1000 gallons of 20% non-emulsifying acid will first be used in each of the pay zones, and the results thereof will determine the number and size of additional stages of acid to be used subsequently. The lower pay zone will be acidized first and the first stage will be used on about October 14, 1949.
