6250' total depth drilled. Ran GR Sonic, Caliper & LL Logs. Set 6250' of 4 1/2" casing w/520 sacks Class G-1-1 Dia. Mix. cement, 12% Gal w/17% Salt, 600 sacks Class G-1-1 Dia. Mix. cement, 8% Gal, 200 sacks Class C cement, 1% Gal across Pay Zone. Tested casing to 1000' for 30 minutes, tested OK. 62 3/4" PWB. Perforated Paddock w/2 3/8" holes per foot (Total 26 holes) from 6086-95' & 6012-06'. Spent 500 gal acid over perforations. Ran 2" tubing w/packer set @ 5972 & seating nipple @ 5969'. Displace acid. On 12 hour potential test ending 11:30 PM, July 30, 1964, flowed 148 Bbls. Oil, no water, on 16/64" choke, TP 275#, 39.3 gvy. @ 60°. 24 hour calculated potential of 296 Bbl. Oil, GOR 540:1.

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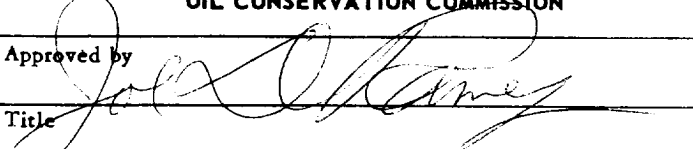
