It is intended to abandon the Bone Spring zone in this well. Bottom hole pressure performance early in the life of this zone indicated that it was a small reservoir and subsequent production decline verified this fact. The zone now pumps 6 BOPD plus 14 BWPD. There is no prospect of increasing production by remedial work and the zone is at its economic limit.

It is intended to:

1. Set retrievable bridge plug above the Wolfcamp perforations.
2. Squeeze the perforated interval from 8,708' to 8,716' with 100 sacks.
3. Return the Wolfcamp to production.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
