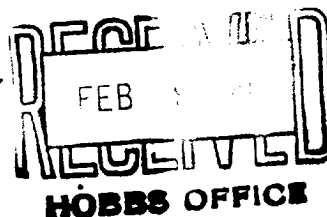

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

2405' Total Depth, Anhydrite. Ran a total of 62 joints of 9-5/8" OD, 40#, J-55 & N-80, R-2 & 3, 8-RT, Smls. Casing New, top joint being N-80 and set at 2399'. Cemented with 1480 sacks of Trinity Regular Bulk Cement, first 1000 sacks mixed 3% Howcogel, and 50 sacks of Incor Cement and plug pumped to 2335' at 3:00AM, 2-2-48. Final pressure 1150#. Cement did not circulate.
