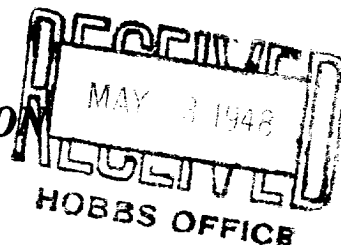

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5208' Drilled Out Depth. Re-perforated well from 5193' to 5207' with 56 holes. Acidized with 500 gallons Dowell X-15% Acid and started acid in tubing with packer open. At 10:15PM acid on formation and set packer at 5185'. Oil flush of 20 bbls. complete at 11:30PM, 4-24-48. Final pressures: osg. 500#, tbg. 600#. Started swabbing 2:30AM, 4-25-48, and load recovered 4:00AM. Well kicked off at 9:00AM ~~and~~ in 4 hrs. on 1/2" choke well flowed 109.64 bbls. fluid, 19% water, gas 676M, GFR 1541, GOR 1903. Put on 1/4" choke and in 18 hrs. to 7:00AM, 4-26-48, flowed 130.72 bbls. fluid, 7.5% water, gas 705M, GFR 4044, GOR 4373, gravity 39.8 corrected. In 24 hrs. to 7:00AM, 4-27-48, flowed 181.47 bbls. fluid, 7.3% water, last 21 hrs. on 2 1/4" choke, gas 1,072,410 cu.ft. per day, gravity 39.8 corrected. Gas-Oil-Ratio 6375.
