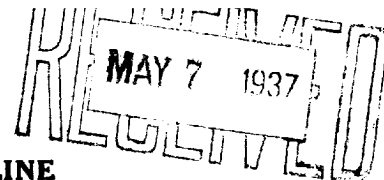

3870' Total depth. Broken line. Set 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " upset tubing at 3866'. Swabbed in and flowed 62 barrels pipe line oil on 4 hour test. Through 1" open choke on 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " upset tubing. Gas volume of 164,000. Gas oil ratio 427. Acidized with 2000 gallons of Dowell XI acid. Acid was flushed with 30 bbls oil. Set 3 hours. Swabbed in and flowed 409 barrels pipe line oil on 8-2/3 hour test. Hourly average of 72 barrels. Flowing through 1" open choke on 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " tubing. Gas volume of 748,000. Gas oil ratio of 433. Tubing pressure 120#. Casing pressure 250#.
