The Atlantic Refining Company respectfully requests administrative approval under provisions of Rule 5 (b) of NMCCO Order No. R-10 for a non-standard gas prevention unit for the Shale (Federal) No. 1 Well located 332' from the south line and 1652' from the west line of Section 31, T-20S, R-36E, Humbert Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. The proposed non-standard gas prevention unit is to consist of 80-acres comprising the S/2 SW/4 of the above described section. Upon approval of this non-standard unit, it is requested that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Administrative Order NMP-20, dated November 30, 1934, covering the SW/4 of Section 31, T-20S, R-36E, Lea County, New Mexico, be cancelled.
