On March 27, 1940, Exmer-Dodge Formation Packer (Size 2" EUE x 5 1/2" OD Casing x 32") was set at 3830'. (This was a reset job as well already had a packer in it)

Production before: (February 15, 1940 - State Test) Flowed 53.31 bbls oil with 545,306 cu. ft. gas. Gas-Oil Ratio 10,228 cuft per bbl.

Production after: (Test on March 30) Flowed 212 bbls oil in 24 hours with 427,200 cu. ft. gas. Gas-Oil ratio 2,015 cu. ft. per bbl.
