RE: Continental Oil Co. Meyer B-26 No. 1
(26-206-3(S))

Reference is made to your telephone conversation with Mr. Macey pertaining to the above-captioned well.

An examination of our records and orders indicates that this well was originally thought to be in SE 1/4 Section 26, whereas it is actually located 2350' from the south line and 6' from the west line of this section.

The well is located outside the boundary of the Eumont Pool, but is in an area which is in all probability part of the Eumont Pool.

Please consider this as temporary approval to produce the well into a gas transportation facility. At such time as the area is taken into the pool it will then be in order for you to apply for approval of an unorthodox location in conformance with the pool rules.

Furthermore, it is our understanding that the well is to be considered as being in Section 26, and the SW/4 of that section will in all probability be dedicated to the well.

A copy of this letter is being sent to El Paso Natural Gas Company and other interested parties.
