DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran and set Baker Model "K" bridge plug at 3620'. Ran Lane Wells Radioactivity log from 2400' to 3818'. Perforated with regular bullets from 3410-3440' (60 shots), 3470-3490' (40 shots), 3520-3523' (6 shots), and 3540-3523' (60 shots). Well unloaded and after gas flow became stabilized tested 10,000 MCFPD. Shut-in 6 hrs. and pressured up to 1050 PSI.
