DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

13-3/8" pipe was run to 226' Oct. 29, 1954. Hole was then bailed dry with pipe swinging off bottom- there was no water. Pipe was then cemented with 110 sack regular cement; plug was stopped at 218' at 9:30 AM- pipe on bottom. Plug was drilled 32 hours later at 5:30 PM October 30, 1954. Pipe was tested for 1 hour after plug was drilled - no water.
