## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On August 15, 1950 at 11:00 A. M., 48 hours had elapsed since cementing the 5-1/2" casing at 7660' with 300 sacks cement. At that time pipe was tested with 1,000 psi for 30 minutes with no pressure drop. 85' of solid cement in bottom of pipe was drilled and water shut-off tested with 1,025 psi for 30 minutes with no pressure drop.

Tests were considered satisfactory and completion operations have been resumed.
