Gentlemen:

Receipt is acknowledged of "Notice of Intention to Drill" dated December 11, 1950, covering your well No. 1 House located on subject land in the C NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, T. 20S, R. 38E, House Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Your proposed work is approved subject to compliance with the provisions of the Oil and Gas Operating Regulations revised May 25, 1942, a copy of which will be furnished you on request, and subject to the following conditions:

1. Drilling operations so authorized are subject to attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
2. The 11 3/4" casing shall be cemented with sufficient cement to reach the surface.
3. Cement behind the 7 5/8" casing should extend about 200 feet above the top of the Salado salt section, as determined by temperature survey to be made within 12 hours after completion of the cement job.
4. Copies of sample log, electrical log, temperature and other surveys made are requested.
