This well was drilled as the Burger B-18 # 1-S well in 1952
Perforations 9070-9242' – Warren Mckee production
In 1952 set a plug at 9200'

In February 1960 re-designated well to SEMU McKee #71 because of enlargement of Southeast Monument Unit area.

In 1983 perforated Abo perforations 6990-7230' – East Skaggs Abo
Set CIBP @ 7850'

Well renamed SEMU Abo # 71

Filed and received approval for dual production in the Skaggs Drinkard 6862-6947' & the East Skaggs Abo 7083-7657' in January 1985

In February 1985 perforated Drinkard 6862-6947' – Skaggs Drinkard pool


In 1985 well incorporated into the Drinkard A participating area

Changed name of well in 1987 to SEMU Burger B # 71

In April 1993 set CIBP @ 7035'

In December 1994 set CIBP At 6598' & Temporarily abandoned the well.

There are currently no perforations (no production) in this well.

 It is Conoco's belief that since this well has no production, that the well name should remain the SEMU Burger B # 71 which is the lease name.
