6. It is proposed to dedicate the NW 1/4 of said Section 27 to said well for the formation of a 160-acre unit for production of gas from the undesignated Tubb Gas Pool. A plat is attached hereto, showing the proposed unit, well location, and offset ownership.



The said plat also shows that applicant is operator of all acreage directly offsetting the proposed gas unit.
