DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill a well with rotary tools at the above location to a total depth of approximately 9270'. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U. S. Geological Survey and any other requirements will be complied with.

It is proposed to use the following casing pattern: 13 3/8" casing to be set at approximately 250' and cemented with 250 sacks, cement to be circulated to surface; 9 5/8" casing to be set at approximately 3000' with 1360 sacks cement, or sufficient cement to protect the salt sections; 7" casing to be set at total depth and cemented with approximately 520 sacks, as determined by survey, and to be perforated opposite the pay section.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
