DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Pumped 300 Bbls. mud in open hole below 5½" casing from 7509' to 7738'. Cut 5½" casing @ 6321' with McCullough Jet Cutter. Pulled casing. Ran 2" tubing and plugged well from 7738 to 7415' with 100 sacks cement, and placed 25 sacks cement from 6370 to 6260. Placed 75 sacks cement from 4639 to 4450. Placed 10 sacks Cal-Seal from 4433 to 4301.

Re-cemented 5½" casing @ 4275 with 200 sacks 4% gel cement, April 9, 1950.
