DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Drilled 12-1/4 inch hole to 330 feet in red beds. Ran 303 feet (7 joints) 8 5/8-inch OD, 24-lb., J-55, EW, ST&C, new, Lone Star casing with Texas pattern shoe and cemented at 314 feet with 200 sacks (100 sacks 2% bentonite and 100 sacks Pozmix). Plug down 9:10 AM, April 19, 1954. WOC 24 hours. Tested casing with 500 psi for 30 minutes. No pressure loss. Drilled plug and drilled 7 7/8-inch hole ahead.
